
eRecording Update: The Lake County Recorder has been 'e-Recording' since 2014. Our vendor Fidlar Technologies is our technology partner and a significant portion of daily work is e-Recordings—which is fast approaching 50%. Most document types e-recorded are Mortgages and Releases. Lake County works with four companies in order to bring e-Recording to our customers. We will be able to add conveyance documents to our eligible document types for e-Recording once we get the Real Estate Transfer Office Auditor and Tax Map on board with the routing software. Standard Recording Guidelines Ohio Revised Code §317.114

- Computer font size of at least 10 point
- Minimum paper size 8 1/2 by 11 inches
- Maximum paper size 8 1/2 by 14 inches Black or Blue ink ONLY
- No use of highlighting
- Margins of 1 inch on each side and bottom of each page
- 3 inch margin on the top of the first page
- 1 1/2 margin on the top of each of the remaining pages

The goal is document standardization. Recorder accepts any document even if it does not conform to these new guidelines. A charge of \$20.00 fee in addition to standard fees will apply. This law does not apply to any documents from any court or taxing authority, Plats, DD214's, any state or federal document, any documents executed before July 1, 2009
