Standard Recording Guidelines Ohio Revised Code §317.114

- Computer font size of at least 10 point
- Minimum paper size 8 ½ by 11 inches
- Maximum paper size 8 ½ by 14 inches
- Black or Blue ink ONLY
- No use of highlighting
- Margins of 1 inch on each side and bottom of each page
- 3 inch margin on the top of the first page
- 1 ½ margin on the top of each of the remaining pages

The goal is document standardization. Recorder accepts any document even if it does not conform to these new guide-lines. A charge of \$20.00 fee in addition to standard fees will apply. This law does **not** apply to any documents from any court or taxing authority, Plats, DD214's, any state or federal document, any documents executed before July 1, 2009
