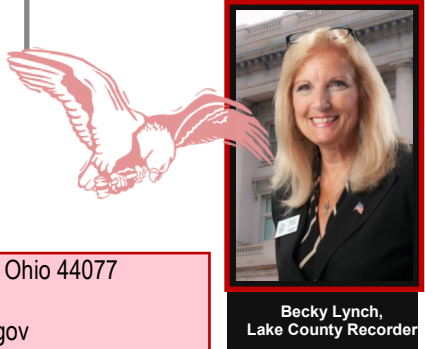

Standard Recording Guidelines Ohio Revised Code §317.114

- Computer font size of at least 10 point
- Minimum paper size – 8 ½ by 11 inches
- Maximum paper size – 8 ½ by 14 inches
- Black or Blue ink ONLY
- No use of highlighting
- Margins-1 inch each side and bottom of each page
- 3 inch margin on the top of the first page
- 1½ margin at top of each of the remaining pages

Recorder accepts document even if it does not conform to these new guidelines. A charge of \$20.00 fee in addition to standard fees will apply. This law does **not** apply to documents from any court or taxing authority, Plats, DD214's, state or federal document, documents executed before July 1, 2009
