The Solar Eclipse coming to our backyard on April 8 will mark moments when the moon covers the sun's face completely, thereby blocking its light, 'in totality' and according to NASA, this will be from 3:13 to 3:17 pm for our area around Cleveland, Ohio. An eerie darkness will fall upon a long swath of the U.S.A. Only during totality will skies turn twilight-dark, and the sun's outer atmosphere, or corona, will be visible as wispy projections of light emanating from behind the moon. The partial phases of the eclipse

last about an hour and 20 minutes before and after totality, and will be visible to some extent across the entire United States. The Lake Countv Recorder Office will be closed for the day on Eclipse Day—April 8th and we wish everyone a memorable and Happy Eclipse Day!

Standard Recording Guidelines Ohio Revised Code §317.114

- Computer font size of at least 10 point
- Minimum paper size 8 1/2 by 11 inches
- Maximum paper size 8 1/2 by 14 inches
- Black or Blue ink ONLY
- No use of highlighting
- Margins of 1 inch on each side and bottom of each page
- 3 inch margin on the top of the first page
- 1 1/2 margin on the top of each of the remaining pages

The goal is document standardization. Recorder accepts any document even if it does not conform to these new guidelines. A charge of \$20.00 fee in addition to standard fees will apply. This law does not apply to any documents from any court or taxing authority, Plats, DD214's, any state or federal document, any documents executed before July 1, 2009
