Sign the document in front of a Notary.

Attach a “certified” copy of the Death Certificate.

Also attach a “legal description” of the property to be transferred (a copy of the Survivorship Deed or Transfer on Death Designation or Deed will suffice).

Take the prepared Affidavit to the Auditor’s Real Estate Transfer Office on the first floor of the County Administration Building (Extension). There will be \$0.50 (Fifty Cents) per parcel charge, and you will need to complete a Tax-Exempt form.

After the Auditor approval, please take the Affidavit to the Recorder’s Office on the lower level of the same building. The fee for recording is \$39.00 for the first two pages and \$8.00 for each additional page, and a \$4.00 Marginal Reference fee for each prior recorded document number referenced.
